

## REVISED

### RESOLUTION REGARDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE TRENTON SCHOOL DISTRICT'S LONG RANGE FACILITIES PLAN TO CONSTRUCT A NEW TRENTON CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL

- WHEREAS,** the Trenton Board of Education is obligated to provide a learning environment that ensues that all of its students are educated in physical facilities that are safe, healthy and conducive to learning that assure that the core curriculum content standards are taught in a setting which facilitates and promotes such learning, and
- WHEREAS,** the Trenton Board of Education has such obligation with regard to students of Trenton Central High School and its high school students throughout the entire City, and
- WHEREAS,** the Trenton School District has expressed its desires to build a new modern high school (including to the extent practical and feasible, the incorporation of iconic elements of the current facility) that provide the required maximum benefit and such project must be approved by the Department of Education and the New Jersey Economic Development Authority, and
- WHEREAS,** the Board of Education has directed the Superintendent and Administration to collaborate with the New Jersey Department of Education to develop and determine a new Proposed Room Inventory Space Program (model) that best supports the educational needs of the District, and
- WHEREAS,** the new Proposed Room Inventory Space Program (model) provides the required square footage, capacity, and program (curriculum spaces) for the construction of a new smaller 1500 student capacity high school at the Chambers Street campus, now therefore
- BE IT RESOLVED** that the Trenton Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent and Administration to submit the revisions of the proposed new Trenton Central High School Proposed Room Inventory Space Program (dated 4/30/08) to the Department of Education for transmittal to the Schools Development Authority,
- ALSO BE IT RESOLVED** the Trenton Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent and Administration to submit the appropriate Department of Education school project electronic application and supporting documentation to the New Jersey Department of Education to secure the necessary approvals related to the amendment of the District's Long Range Facility Plan; thereby initiating the procurement process and requesting the necessary professional services to complete the design and construction of a new modern high school (including to the extent practical and feasible, the incorporation of iconic elements of the current facility).
